

## **Events sustainability policy**


By performing business operations in a sustainable manner, OGR Torino are pursuing **excellence in conducting exhibitions and events**. As organisers and/or promoters of live events, OGR Torino acknowledge that their activities have an impact on the environment, on the economy and on the community. These impacts are taken into account when making business decisions, so as to ensure an offer of services that is sustainable for future growth.

Moreover, OGR Torino acknowledge their key role in raising awareness of sustainability issues among their suppliers and customers.

OGR Torino are committed to establishing a sustainability control system in all its facilities, projects and operations in connection with the events.

In line with the principles, declaration of intent and values, and the implementation of the sustainable development policy, OGR Torino also commit to:

- integrate sustainability considerations into all business decisions in all its facilities, projects and operations.
- establish a fundamental set of sustainable development principles incorporating Social Accountability.
- implement the voluntary ISO 20121 standard for any business decisions in all its facilities, projects and operations.
- Allocate sufficient resources to meet the requirements of the event sustainability control system.
- Communicate with the employees and raise stakeholders' awareness of sustainability policies, values and principles, encouraging them to adopt sustainability control practices and directly involving them in OGR Torino's initiatives.
- Ensure that the events will leave a positive legacy.



- Ensure that the outcome of engaging with stakeholders is taken into account, as well as the needs of end users.
- Ensure that appropriate training is provided to employees, particularly the operations team handling the events, so that they will have the competence to perform their duties in relation to the sustainable development policy and key sustainability issues.
- Comply with all approved legislation and codes of conduct and ensure that the impact of future legislation on such events will be taken into account.
- Maintaing safe and healthy working conditions for OGR Torino's employees.
- Decrease the amount of waste sent to landfill through general reduction targets and alternative on-site recovery activities, creating new relationships that facilitate their development and ensure sustainability
- Continuously monitor the sustainability performance of suppliers and contractors.
- Continuously review and strive to improve the Integrated Control and Sustainability System.
- Review and communicate the Sustainability Policy and other key documents related to ISO 20121 at regular intervals and when necessary, in line with the life cycle of events.
- Ensure that all new capabilities acquired as a result of developments within the scope of application, such as new knowledge, training, standards, best practices, skills, organisation and systems, are taken into account and integrated into the control system.
